

Some Suggestions Regarding Homework

Homework is an important part of the step-by-step understanding of the material learned in class that day. Usually homework will consist of questions that will test or reinforce the learning of that day. As you review the lessons given each day, you will also join your new knowledge in the subject area with knowledge gained in previous lessons.

Some facts about homework:

1. It is your responsibility. Do it for your own sake.
2. Most teachers will periodically check homework and often marks are assigned,
3. Keep all material related to a particular subject in one section of your binder. Do not scatter your materials; they may be forgotten or lost later.
4. If there is something you don't understand, ask about it as soon as possible.
5. If you miss a day or an assignment, obtain the notes the next day so that there are no gaps in your knowledge. It is your responsibility to complete missed assignments and to catch up on missed work.
6. The requirements for different subjects will often vary widely. Yours Teachers will let you know about the expectations in each course.
